## Directive on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE)

The WEEE Directive sets targets that 65% of IT equipment must be recycled and materials such as, LCD displays, printed circuit boards, batteries and flame retardant plastics be pre-treated before disposal.

By using Eserve.it services, your organisation can provide demonstrable compliance to the WEEE Directive.

## What your business needs to know

The WEEE Directive introduces new responsibilities for businesses when they dispose of their WEEE. Businesses need to ensure all separately collected WEEE is treated, recycled and recovered.

Whether the business or the producer of the electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) pays for this depends on the circumstances.

## Reporting

If businesses have obligations for the treatment, recycling and recovery of WEEE they will need to report evidence of this to the Environment Agency. Eserve.it can provide this documentation on behalf of your business.
